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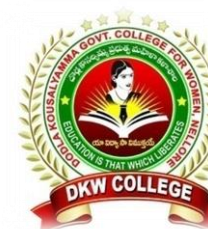

Guidelines for Submission and Presentation

A member may present only one research paper in any one section during the Session.* Footnotes should be properly formatted and placed at the end of the paper.* The research paper should be 10–12 pages long.* The paper should be neatly typed and submitted in Microsoft Word format. Line spacing: Double spacing.* Font: Times New Roman. Font size: 12 pt. The title page should include:

Author's Name, Address, Email ID, & Mobile Number

*The Section in which the author wishes to present the paper.

* Please upload your research paper through the Google Form link provided in the Local Secretary's circular as soon as possible.

* The last date for uploading research papers is 15th December 2026. Papers should be submitted along with the delegate fee only.

* Two hard copies of the research paper, along with a brief summary, should be submitted to the Secretary, Permanent Office, D.K. Government College for Women (A), Nellore, on 9th and 10th January 2027.

* All paper presenters must follow the APHC Research Paper Style Sheet, available on the official AP History Congress website.

* Research papers that do not follow the prescribed APHC Research Paper Style Sheet may be rejected without further notice.

* Submitting a research paper does not automatically guarantee publication. Papers will be considered for publication in the APHC Annual Journal based on the recommendations of the Sectional Presidents, Editorial Board, and Peer Review Committee of the APHC.
